

BETHEL COLORGUARD INFORMATION SHEET

There will be a colorguard class offered after school this year at Bethel Middle School. We will meet on Tuesday and Thursday from 3:30 until 4:45. Students will be taught basic fundamentals of flag twirling, proper posture, hand position and some basic dance steps as well. There will be routines set to music and the group will perform at several events during the school year. This is NOT an audition group – any student who is interested and willing to purchase the uniform and equipment is welcome. *The only pre-requisite is that the students are all current 7th or 8th grade band members.*

Students who wish to participate will be responsible for purchasing their own equipment and a uniform. These items are listed below. Total cost will be kept as minimal as possible and exact prices will be given after the number of students participating is finalized.

Uniform – Lyrical dance dress – approximately \$50.00 (any boys wishing to participate will have slacks and a dress shirt). Dresses are long sleeved, scoop necked, polyester/lycra, ankle length dresses. They are machine washable – Royal Blue.

Tights and shoes – still looking for these – will try to purchase these locally

Flag pole - \$13.00

Flag – \$15.00

Students MUST attend rehearsals or they will be removed from the Bethel colorguard. They only excused rehearsals will be for illness or if they are pre-arranged.

The goal is to teach the fundamentals of flag twirling/performance; self-esteem building; teamwork; physical fitness; and, of course, fun!
